Koch Fertilizer, LLC and its affiliates own or have interests in nitrogen fertilizer plants in the United States, Canada, Trinidad and Tobago, and Venezuela; and cover global demand through state-of-the-art terminals in the U.S., Canada and Europe. The company and its affiliates; including Koch Fertilizer Trading, Sarl, Koch Fertilizer Products, SAS and Koch Fertiliser, Ltd. have the capability to manufacture, market and distribute more than 10 million metric tons of fertilizer products annually.

Flint Hills Resources, LLC, through its subsidiaries, is a leading refining and chemicals company. It markets products such as gasoline, diesel, jet fuel, olefins, polymers and intermediate chemicals as well as base oils and asphalt. The company operates three refineries in the United States (Alaska, Minnesota and Texas) with a combined crude oil processing capacity of more than 800,000 barrels per day. These commodity chemicals are marketed and distributed from offices in Europe.

It also markets paper towel, napkin and soap dispensing systems used in commercial settings. The packaging business is one of the United States' largest suppliers of corrugated containers to manufacturers. The building products businesses have long been among the nation's leading suppliers to lumber and building materials dealers and do-it-yourself warehouse retailers.
